### **Sanford Avenue Completion and Unveiling of Sanford Avenue Heritage Markers Thursday, November 20<sup>th</sup> 4:30 PM**

Join the City of Sanford as we celebrate the completion of the Sanford Avenue Streetscape Project and the unveiling of the heritage markers, which are part of the City's [Pathways to History project](#). *Pathways to History* was created by Christine Dalton, AICP, the City's Historic Preservation Officer, and consist of 8 themed walking/driving tours focused on Sanford's history and development. The content for the heritage markers on Sanford Avenue were developed by the Georgetown Heritage Advisory Committee with assistance from the Sanford Museum and Sanford Historical Society. The markers have been funded by a federal *Preserve America* grant and Sanford's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA).

The unveiling will be held at 4:30 PM in Palucci Park (southwest corner of Sanford Avenue and 1<sup>st</sup> Street). At 5:30 PM Christine Dalton and Georgetown Heritage Advisory Committee member Patricia Black will give a presentation at the Historic Sanford Welcome Center located at 203 E. 1<sup>st</sup> St., Sanford, that will focus on the history of Georgetown and Sanford Avenue's development. At 7 PM Christine Dalton will lead a tour down Sanford Avenue to visit the 8 marker locations. All activities are free and open to the public.

"The CRA is very excited about the completion of the Sanford Avenue Streetscape Project. This is a testament to the success of the City of Sanford and the CRA's commitment to supporting downtown development", said Maria Shreve, Chairperson of the Sanford CRA.

Food and refreshments will be provided at the Historic Sanford Welcome Center during the presentation/reception, sponsored by the Sanford CRA.
