Builders Blitz Dedication Ceremony Wednesday, June 17, 5:30 pm 922 W. 11 St. Sanford

Habitat for Humanity of Seminole County & Greater Apopka was chosen to host the national kick off for the Home “Builders Blitz” right here in Sanford. Across the nation, over 200 homes were built in one week June 8-12. Two Sanford homes were part of the festivities; one home renovated on Garrison Street in Sanford and on 11th Street, a new home was built. e2 Homes of Maitland led the two builds with its 53 local vendors to have completed the homes in just one week.

Please join us for a dedication ceremony of the two homes in Sanford that will take place on Wednesday, June 17th at 5:30 pm. at 922 W. 11st. which is the property location of the newly constructed home. Following the ceremony, the 119 Garrison Ave. renovated home will be available for the public to tour.
