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Golf Carts Soon to Be Seen on Designated Sanford Streets

At its February 11, 2013 meeting, the Sanford City Commission passed an ordinance that allows for golf carts to be legally driven on designated Sanford City streets beginning March 1, 2013.

Registration for golf cart usage is intended to begin the week of February 25th with registration forms, a map of the designated streets and list of safety requirements made available at City Hall's Building Department, 300 N. Park Avenue and also on the city's website www.sanfordfl.gov under Latest News.

There is a two-step process to register a golf cart in the City of Sanford. First process is to visit City Hall's Building Department to pay a \$25 annual fee. To register a golf cart please bring to City Hall proof of ownership, such as a bill of sale, and your driver's license.

The second part of the process starts by calling the Police to schedule an inspection of the golf cart at your location. After passing the inspection, you will be provided a decal to be placed visibly on the golf cart.

Whether it is for simple convenience or to help preserve the environment, using golf carts on designated streets will soon be an option to Sanford residents. The City also plans to explore additional areas where golf carts will be able to be used as an alternative mode of transportation.

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
