City of Sanford Marina Day Slips Completion Ceremony Thursday, November 21 at 10:30 a.m.

The City of Sanford will be hosting a Marina Day Slips Completion Ceremony on November 21 at 10:30 a.m. Mayor Jeff Triplett and other dignitaries will be in attendance. The address of the ceremony is 400 N. Park Ave. Sanford, FL 32771.

The marina slips were funded by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection through the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program, Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission through the Florida Boating Improvement Program and the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners Boating Improvement Program totaling, \$440,000.

The project is designed to provide day time mooring for boaters traveling along the St. Johns River. There are eleven day slips. There is also a fixed pier and landing ramp for boaters to have access to the downtown area. The dock system has been designed to float and match the varying lake levels throughout the year.

Located at the top of the ramp is a three sided Informational Kiosk that names Veterans Memorial Park and its contributors, a directional map of amenities in the downtown area, and an advertisement portion to note any special events happening in the City.

“Thanks to our funding partners, the marina day slips will provide new opportunities for boaters to enjoy Lake Monroe and to visit Historic Sanford with their friends and families. This is a wonderful new recreational amenity the City of Sanford can be very proud of. Lake Monroe is a valuable asset to the residents and visitors of Sanford. With Florida’s great weather, we look forward to the docks being busy all the time,” said Mayor Triplett.

The contractor for the project was S.E. Cline Construction Inc. of Palm Coast, Florida and the pre-engineered docks were provided by Bellingham Marine of Jacksonville, Florida.
