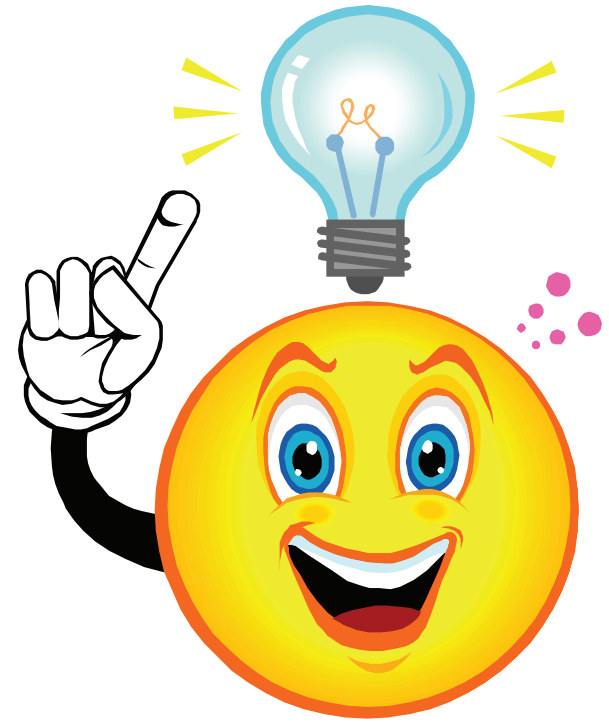
The Low-Income Home Energy Program

(L.I.H.E.A.P.) provides grants to local governments and non profit agencies to assist eligible low-income households in meeting the costs of home heating and cooling.

Home Energy Assistance is available once every twelve(12) months to low income households in Seminole County. A one-time benefit payment will be made on behalf of the applicant.

L.I.H.E.A.P.

Crisis is available once per heating season and once per cooling season within a year for Seminole County residents. Crisis Energy Assistance will assist households who do not have, or are in danger of losing home energy.

REQUIREMENTS FOR
L.I.H.E.A.P. ASSISTANCE

1. Eligibility is based on 12 months of gross income for EACH household member being served, 18 years and over (provided most recent income tax statement current year).
2. Provided all income earned in the past twelve (12) months for all members of the household, 18 years and over. This includes the following: (If you do not have any income, you must explain how you support your household).
 - AFDC/TANF
 - ALIMONY
 - CHILD SUPPORT
 - EMPLOYMENT
(check stubs, income tax statements)
 - FOOD STAMPS
 - PENSION
 - SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS
 - UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS
 - VA BENEFITS
 - OTHER INCOME RECEIVED
(cash from family or friends)
3. If you are a section 8 or HUD Recipient, please provide rent verification/section 8 voucher. If NOT please provide lease agreement or mortgage papers, deed.

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program

Need assistance with your electric bill?

Home Energy Assistance will assist eligible households in paying for energy heating and cooling costs. A one-time home energy benefit payment will be made on behalf of the applicant and all persons living in the applicant's home. Payments will be made on a first come first served basis as long as funds remain available. Applicants that don't provide required information before benefits funds are obligated will be denied. Proof of home energy bill is usually required and should be attached.

Program Objectives: Home Energy assistance helps eligible households in meeting the cost of home energy. Crisis Assistance helps eligible households resolve or mitigate a home energy crisis.

The City of Sanford LIHEAP Program is a service for Seminole County residents only. You may be eligible if your household size and income are not more than 150% of the poverty guidelines.

Walk-ins are not accepted and appointments are scheduled by telephone only!

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4. If you are 18 years of age and a full time student please provide verification from the school he/she is attending.
5. Most recent electric statement:
 - REGULAR
 - PAST DUE
 - FINAL
 - DISCONNECT
6. SOCIAL SECURITY CARD
 - APPLICANT
 - ALL OTHER HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS
7. PICTURE IDENTIFICATION
 - APPLICANT
8. ADDITIONAL information may be required/ requested upon the case workers request.

Note: The Above information is required to process your application. All required information MUST be provided to determined eligibility. If you do not have this information at the time of your appointment, you will be given two (2) to ten (10) days, depending in your situation, to provide the information that is required or requested.
