We are thrilled to have one of the world's acknowledged guitar masters, [Larry Coryell](#) as the featured artist on Saturday, April 3. Larry has recorded more than 75 albums over the past 40 years as a bandleader, soloist and 'featured accompanist'. Hailed by his legion of fans as one of "the guitar gods" in the late 1970s and as a "truly

Renaissance musician who excels at all styles of playing", he has also been christened as "a true pioneer of rock-jazz fusion" by the New York Times, and dubbed "the Godfather of Fusion" by Down Beat Magazine.

Joining Larry on drums is Marty Morell. Marty was a member of the BILL EVANS TRIO for seven years - longer than any other drummer. A highly inventive player, capable of both great subtlety and fiery dynamics, Morell has worked and/or recorded with the Al Cohn-Zoot Sims Quintet, Henry "Red" Allen, Gary McFarland, Steve Kuhn and Gabor Szabo.
