



Save With Alternative Water

- Alternative Water Supplies (AWS) include reclaimed water, stormwater, shallow wells and brackish water.
- AWS primary function is irrigation and is utilized throughout the City and surrounding areas.
- It is NOT for drinking, bathing or filling swimming pools.
- Other possible uses for AWS include commercial car washing, industrial process cooling, concrete mixing and decorative fountains.
- AWS is safe for irrigation of edible crops that will be peeled, skinned or thermally processed before consumption. All others must be irrigated indirectly.
- AWS could be subject to water restrictions. For more information, please contact Customer Service at 407-330-5630.

Alternative Water Supplies Will Help You Save.

- AWS helps you save groundwater.
- Metered AWS helps you save money. The consumption charge per 1,000 gallons is less than that of potable water.

NOTE: Reclaimed Water Service Areas Are Limited.

- Reclaimed water service expansion to your property is based on demand, reclaimed water availability, cost effectiveness and budget restraints.
- Charges for metered AWS will appear on a separate customer bill similar to your current utility bill.



The City of Sanford utilizes AWS to augment its reclaimed water. This helps provide added reliability while expanding reuse and recharge in and around Sanford, and with its partners, the City of Lake Mary and Seminole County.

AWS is needed as a water resource.

AWS can work as a separate source or be combined to help meet future water demands. With additional treatment, AWS from the St. Johns River or brackish wells can meet potable water standards. This will expand drinking water sources but, at a much higher cost. Through using Alternative Water Supplies, Sanford joins a number of cities in Florida and around the nation, that are protecting the environment while better utilizing resources.
