Map is not to scale. Points marked with yellow paint and nails in the pavement.

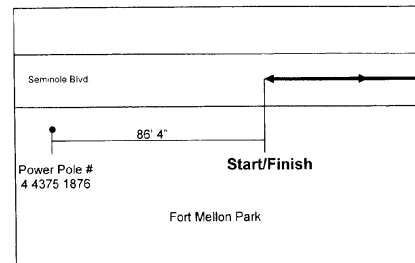
Start/Finish – On Seminole Blvd., to the north of Fort Mellon Park, 86 feet 4 inches east of power pole # 4 4375 1876.

Mile 1 – On First Street, just east of the intersection with Sanford Ave., 2 feet 4 inches west of power pole # 4 4275 9370.

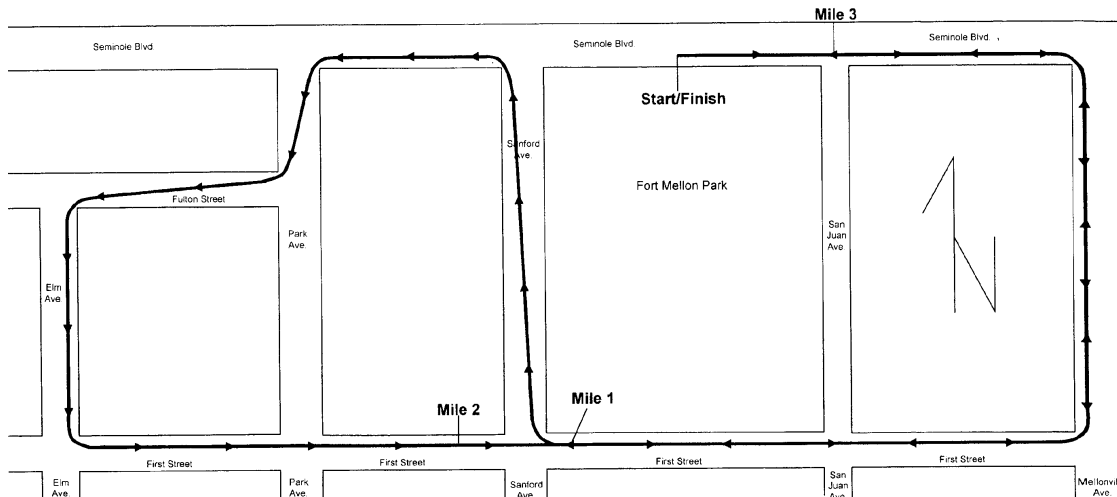
Mile 2 – On First Street, even with the front door for the building at 215 First Street.

Mile 3 – On Seminole Blvd., in the center of the intersection with San Juan Avenue.
