### **Sanford Police Arrest Suspect in Connection with Alleged Kidnapping**

Sanford, FL (October 10, 2018): Sanford Police arrested Tedrick Mazion on charges related to the alleged kidnapping incident on October 7, 2018, of his daughter.

On October 7, 2018, at 8:38 am, Sanford Police responded to disturbance at The Park at Ravello, located at 401 West Seminole Boulevard. Witnesses stated that Tedrick Mazion, entered the residence and removed his three month old daughter. Shortly after, the child's mother made an attempt to stop Mazion from leaving with the infant, and was grabbed and pushed by Mazion. Mazion then fled the area with the three month old. Hours later, the infant was returned to the apartment complex by Ronita Mack, an associate of Mazion.

On October 9, 2018, a warrant was issued for Tedrick Mazion for charges in connection with this incident.

On October 10, 2018, Tedrick Mazion turned himself in to the Sanford Police Department without incident. Mazion was arrested and charged with Burglary with Assault/Battery and Battery –Domestic Violence. Mazion was additionally arrested on an outstanding warrant for Aggravated Stalking –Domestic Violence and Written Threats to Do Harm related to a previous Sanford Police Investigation.

Chief Smith stated “We were relieved that the young infant was returned to her mother unharmed and in good health. The quick actions, hard work, and dedication of the officers and investigators directly contributed to this positive outcome. Today's conclusion was peaceful and without incident which is the best possible conclusion.”

Mazion was transported to John E Polk Correctional Facility without incident where he is being held on ‘No Bond’.
