Sanford Police Assist in the Investigation of a Nationwide Bomb Threat

Sanford, FL (December 13, 2018): Sanford Police responded to a bomb threat, located at Career Source Central Florida (1209 West Airport Boulevard).

On December 13, 2018, at approximately 1:27 pm, Sanford Police Department responded to 1209 West Airport Boulevard (Career Source Central Florida). A series of possible bomb threats were received (nationwide), via email, which included a local business in the City of Sanford. The email threats included demands for a certain amount of Bitcoin or an explosive device would be detonated. Information gathered during the investigation, indicates that it is possibly a nationwide series of threats. Although there was no confirmation of any suspicious package at the business, various businesses and schools were evacuated during the investigation. Any additional information, would have to be obtained from the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
