

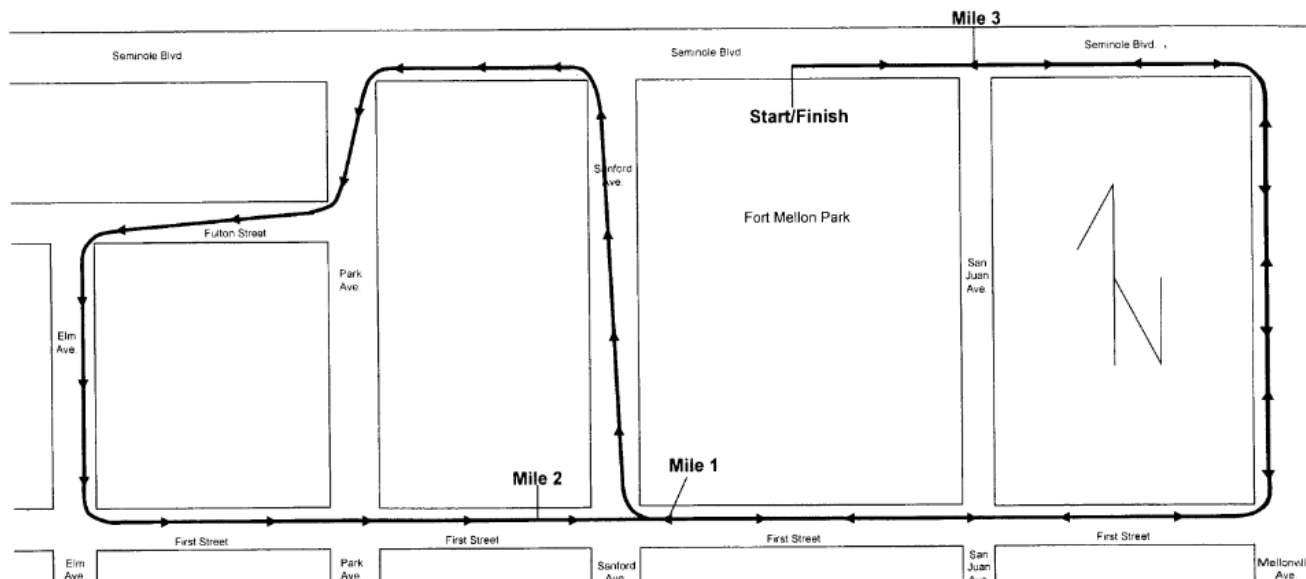
Street Closure Notification
