## The 8<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Johns River Festival of the Arts

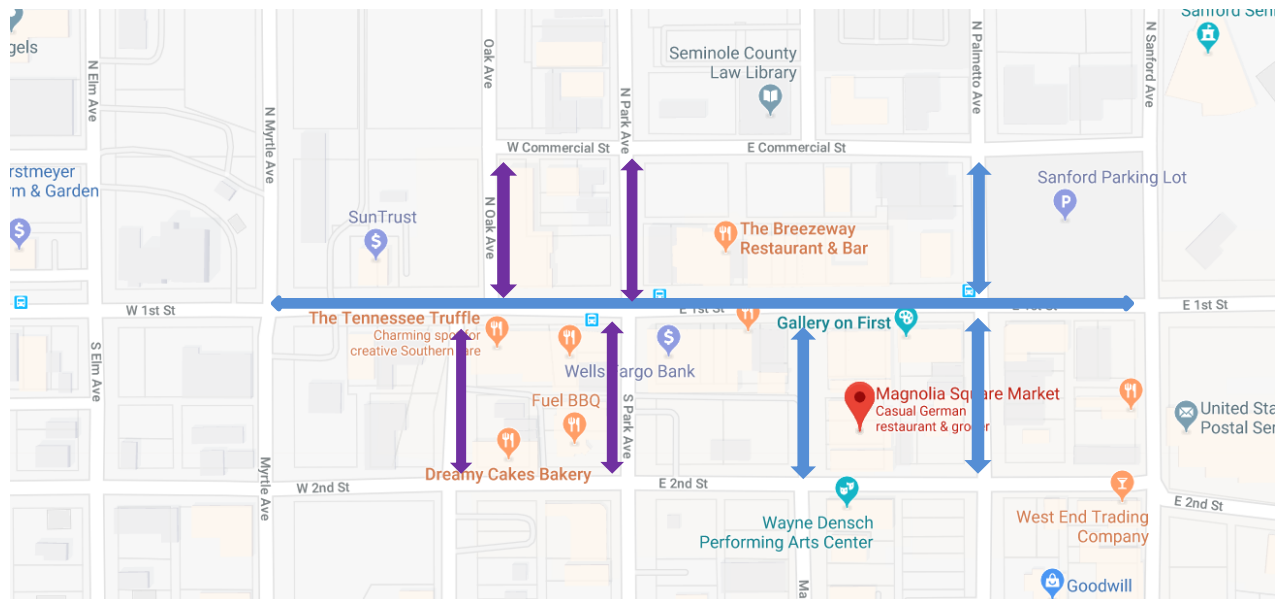

The City Commission will be presented with the following Special Event Permit Request at the 7 PM Commission Meeting on February 25, 2019. Downtown Sanford will be transformed into an artist mecca with art work from some of the best artists across the country for the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Johns River Festival of the Arts on Saturday, May 4, 2019 from 10 AM until 6 PM and on Sunday, May 5, 2019 from 10 AM until 5 PM.

The requested road closures are highlighted with “blue” depicting the event area and “violet” reflecting the secondary street closures necessary since vehicles would not have an exit route. The event space includes rental of Magnolia Square and 1<sup>st</sup> Street Courtyard. 1<sup>st</sup> Street Merchants may have to receive deliveries utilizing alleyways before and after the event hours. - 1<sup>st</sup> Street, from Myrtle Avenue to Sanford Avenue;
- Magnolia Avenue, from the Square to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street; and
- Oak Avenue, Park Avenue and Palmetto Avenue, from Commercial Street to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.
