SANDBAGS

The City of Sanford has sandbags available 24/7 through Sunday, Sept. 1 at 800 W. Fulton St. Sanford, city staff on site 8am-6pm. The bagging location is outside the gate of the Public Works Complex. Residents must bring their own shovel. There is a limit of 20 bags per household.

GARBAGE AND COLLECTION SERVICE

Due to the weather situation with Hurricane Dorian and Landfill closures, there will be NO garbage or recycle collection for residents or commercial businesses located within the city limits of Sanford on Monday, September 2, 2019 and Tuesday, September 3, 2019.

Dale Aquatic Center, the Tim Raines Sports Park and the Sanford Museum will remain closed from Sunday, September 1st through Tuesday, September 3rd.
