

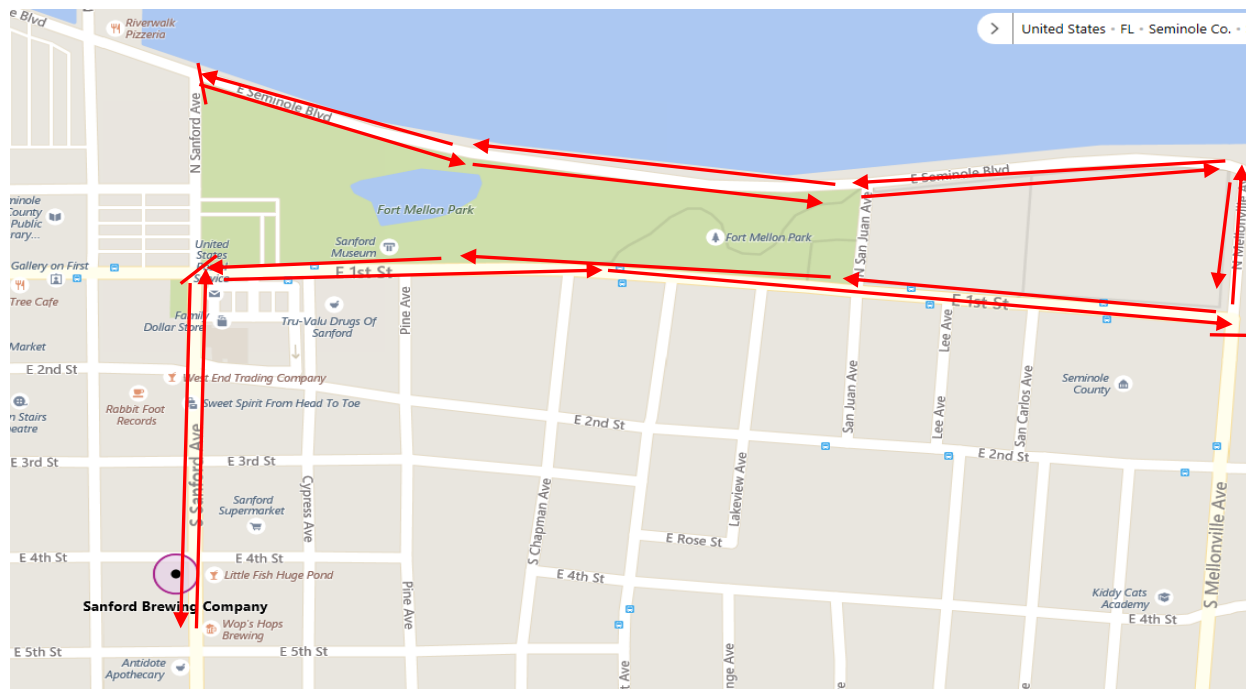
Special Notification of Street Closure(s)

Jim Payne 5K 5 – 11 AM on Saturday, March 21, 2020

Wop’s Hops Brewing Company, Sanford’s first microbrewery, is requesting to sponsor the Jim Payne 5K at 8 AM on Saturday, March 21, 2020. Individuals and Company Teams are encouraged to run or walk this fast and flat 5K benefiting Kids House Children’s Advocacy Center - Seminole County’s child abuse prevention and treatment center.

This 5K course originates and ends on Sanford Avenue, between 4th and 5th Street. The applicant requests closure of Sanford Avenue, from 5th Street to 1st Street; 1st Street, from Sanford Avenue to Mellonville Avenue; Mellonville Avenue, from 1st Street to Seminole Boulevard; and Seminole Boulevard from Mellonville Avenue to Sanford Avenue, where it doubles back to the Start/Finish line on Sanford Avenue near 5th Street from 5-11 AM on Saturday, March 21, 2020.
