

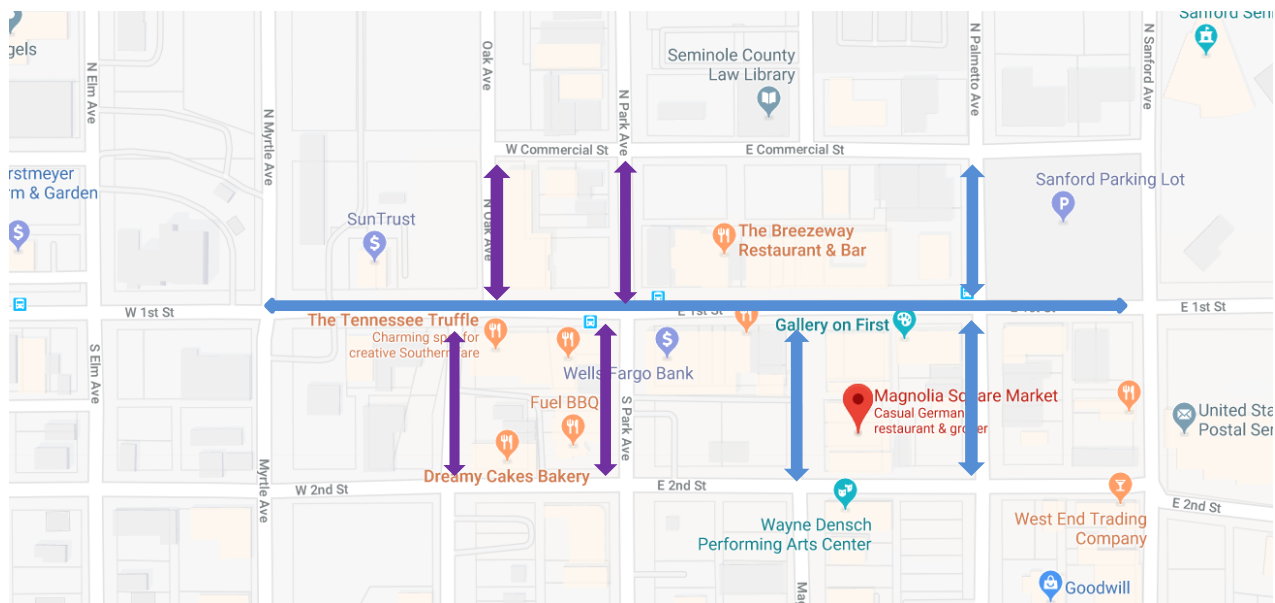
Special Notification of Street Closure(s)

St. Johns River Festival of the Arts 1 PM on Friday, May 1 until 11 PM on Sunday, May 3, 2020

The City Commission will be presented with the following Special Event Permit Request at the 7 PM Commission Meeting on December 9, 2019. If you have any comments that you would like the City Commission to review along with this request, please email them to Jennifer.Brooks@sanfordfl.gov.

Downtown Sanford will be transformed into an artist mecca with art work from some of the best artists across the country for the 9th Annual St. Johns River Festival of the Arts on Saturday, May 2, 2020 and from 10 AM until 6 PM and on Sunday, May 3, 2020 from 10 AM until 5 PM. The requested street closures are highlighted with “blue” depicting the event area and “violet” reflecting the secondary street closures necessary since vehicles would not have an exit route. The event space includes rental of Magnolia Square and 1st Street Courtyard. 1st Street Merchants may have to receive deliveries utilizing alleyways before and after the event hours. Applicant will ensure that vendors and artists tents do not interfere with alley access. Additional information is available at www.stjohnsriverartfest.com.

- Magnolia Avenue, from the Square to 2nd Street; and
- Oak Avenue, Park Avenue and Palmetto Avenue, from Commercial Street to 2nd Street.
