Temporary Signage for Sanford Restaurants Now Allowed

Due to the unprecedented emergency situation in dealing with the COVID-19 virus and our efforts to support small businesses, as of March 24, 2020, the City will be temporarily allowing restaurants to place additional outside signage identifying the business is open for carryout and/or delivery service.

The temporary signage should be A-frame (sandwich board) or placard type sign not to exceed 9 square feet in size. Up to two (2) signs may be placed in front of a business.

Additionally, businesses may temporarily designate one (1) public parking space for curb service pick-up. One additional sign not to exceed 9 square feet may be placed curbside to mark the designated parking space.

These allowances will be in effect until the expiration of the current Local State of Emergency or until further notice from the City, whichever occurs first.
