City Commission Appoints Art Woodruff As Mayor of Sanford City Commission Accepting Applications for District 1 Commission Seat

Due to the recent resignation of Jeff Triplett as Mayor, under the provisions of the City Charter, it was the responsibility of the City Commission to appoint a Mayor. At the Monday, June 8 City Commission meeting, the Commission voted to appoint District 1 Commissioner, Art Woodruff as Mayor. Mayor Woodruff will serve through December 2022, the remaining term of former Mayor Jeff Triplett.

With the District 1 Commission seat now vacant, the City Commission will be accepting applications to appoint a new District 1 Commissioner.

A City Commissioner is part of the local governing body of the City of Sanford and will serve with a Mayor and three (3) other City Commissioners. The appointed City Commissioner will begin his/her term of office upon appointment with a term ending date in December 2022.

All candidates must be a resident of District 1, a registered voter and not a convicted felon whose civil rights have not been restored, in the City of Sanford. The City Commission meets twice a month on the 2nd and 4th Monday with the exception of November and December. As part of the City Commission, the individual will be responsible for the establishment and adoption of policy in the City of Sanford. The current annual salary is \$19,935.46.

[Applications](#) will be accepted up until noon, Monday, June 22, 2020. The City Commission will review all applications at its June 22 Work Session at 4pm. A selection will be made at their June 22 Regular Meeting at 7pm or a subsequent meeting.
