# **New Traffic Pattern on Seminole Blvd. Begins Monday, August 17**

Due to the RiverWalk Phase 3 Trail and Roadway project, starting August 17 the traffic pattern on Seminole Boulevard will shift east from the Central Florida Zoo entrance to Walnut Crest Run. The residents of The Preserves will have no access to the east and will have to enter and exit westward to Monroe Road (CR15/17-92).

**SEMINOLE BOULEVARD WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN MONROE VIEW TRAIL AND WALNUT CREST RUN.**

Residents of Venetian Bay, Regatta Shores and Lake Monroe Apartments will still have to enter and exit from the east. This traffic pattern will last approximately 10 weeks. The RiverWalk Trail and Roadway project has a 515-day completion schedule with the entire project anticipated to be complete by October of 2021; however, the COVID-19 pandemic will probably affect the completion time.
